Luc Imsand is an independent artist formed at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston.

The city and the energetic, everyday life interactions amongst it's inhabitants is his particular focus.

Imsand was born in 1960 in Lausanne, Switzerland where he works and resides today.

Imsand paints people in places that show their activities and desires.

The artist depicts what he sees around him as an actor and chronicler of urban landscapes.

He has traveled extensively through North and South America as well as Asia.

He also have shows in Glasgow, Lausanne, Lübeck, Turin, Lille, Düsseldorf, Bonn, Bratislava, Prague, Paris, Rotterdam, Miami, Stuttgart and Geneva.

He has witnessed the beauty of nature but he doesn't paint it preferring instead to concentrate on the mostly gloomy and changing atmospheres of urban living; sometimes threatening and sometimes on the edge of destruction.

His perspective is that of a burning mirror. Not considering the city as a modern paradise, Imsand depicts it, in joyful primary colours, as a place of burning desires and addictions: alcohol, drugs, money, televisions, sex and computers. These addictions are for many the expression of a need to feel alive.
